CALL FOR CONTRIBUTED PAPERS

HISTORY

The IV Latin American Congress on Mathematical Biology emerges from the commitment made by Latin American researchers with the purpose of developing and strengthening the interdisciplinary work of mathematical modeling in the Biosciences, encouraging the exchange of knowledge across borders, uniting efforts in joint projects, and participating in the training of new scientists in the region.

This proposal originated in the activities developed by the Latin American Society for Biomathematics on the one hand, and the Latin American Network for Mathematical Ecology on the other. After several years of parallel activities, the former with the Latin American Congress on Biomathematics and the latter with the Latin American Meetings on Mathematical Ecology, and following a suggestion by Brazilian colleagues, it was proposed to unite members of both groups into a unique society. In 2001, the first of the joint meetings (X CLAB and V ELAEM), took place in Campinas, Brazil. In 2002, the Congress was held in Guanajuato, Mexico, and in 2003 in Armenia, Colombia.

During the Assembly held in 2003, Tandil, Argentina, was chosen as the location of the 2005 Congress.

CALL FOR CONTRIBUTED PAPERS

For this new edition of *the Latin American Congress on Mathematical Biology (XIII CLAB & VIII ELAEM)*, the areas that have been traditionally covered, such as Population Genetics, Epidemiology, Toxicology, Population Dynamics, Natural Resource Management, Physiology and Computational Biology, will be included. Other new subjects that may be proposed will be accepted if the Scientific Committee considers that they are pertinent.

PRELIMINARY PROGRAM

- The **first week, from October 31**st **to November 5**th, will be devoted to short courses on the state-of-the art for graduate and advanced undergraduate students, but researches wishing to be updated in particular subjects are welcome to attend. Very soon, and as confirmations arrive, the list of speakers and their subjects will be published in the web site.
- The **second week, from November 6th till November 11th**, will be dedicated to the usual Congress activities, with simultaneous sessions, plenary conferences, poster presentations, round tables, etc.

Abstracts may be submitted in Spanish or Portuguese, should have a translation into English and include title of the contribution, author's name, institution's name, postal address and email address. The text should not exceed 500 words.

Abstracts should be e-mailed as MS Word documents, bearing the author's name as file name, to the address bellow.

FULL PAPERS

The deadline for the reception of full papers is <u>December 16th</u>, <u>2005</u>. The format for their presentation will be communicated in next announcements.

REVIEWS

The abstracts will be submitted to the Scientific Committee for review, and the authors will be notified of their acceptance by September 30th, 2005.

The full papers will be submitted to peer review and those accepted will be published in digital format. The Scientific Committee will make a selection of papers for their publication in international scientific journals.
